

# PROGRAM HISTORY

## ABOUT ONESIGHT

OneSight<sup>®</sup>, a Luxottica Group Foundation, is a family of charitable programs dedicated to improving vision for those in need worldwide through outreach, research and education. OneSight combines more than 20 years of innovation from three former Luxottica charitable programs – Give the Gift of Sight and the Pearle Vision Foundation in North America and Community I-Care in Australia – into one, new global foundation. Since 1986, these charitable efforts have provided free vision care and eyewear to more than seven million people in need around the world and have granted millions towards research and education.

## 1986 **OneSight Research programs begin in North America** (formerly known as the Pearle Vision Foundation)

- **1988** **OneSight Outreach programs begin in North America** (formerly known as Give the Gift of Sight) to collect used eyewear and provide vouchers for free new eyewear
- **1991** **First OneSight Global Clinic** to Costa Rica: 8,600 people helped
- **1993** **OneDay** is established across all LensCrafters stores, creating the single, largest day of giving within the OneSight program
- **1994** **OneSight honored with the United States President's Volunteer Action Award** (honors volunteers that give hundreds of thousands of hours per year helping others) for its commitment to providing eye care to the underprivileged
- **1995** **OneSight North America launches "Seemore," OneSight's first Vision Van** to bring eye care to children in need
- **1998** **"Iris" joined the Vision Van fleet** in North America
- **1999** **One millionth recipient**, Jessica, a young school girl is helped in Washington, United States  
**OneSight receives Award for Excellence in Corporate Community Service** (celebrating success for charitable giving in the community) from the Points of Light Foundation  
**Sight Night** is launched to collect used eyewear in conjunction with Halloween. To date, over 1,000,000 have been collected
- **2001** **OneSight celebrates 10 years of Global Clinics**; 753,662 helped on Cissions to date  
**Two millionth recipient**, Julia, a grandmother, is helped in Bolivia
- **2003** **OneSight programs begin in Asia Pacific** (formerly Community I-Care) including a partnership with Croc Festival™ to provide free vision care & eyewear to children in remote parts of Australia and establish the first eye care Clinics in Fiji  
**Three millionth recipient**, Gabriel, a young boy, is helped in Ecuador
- **2004** **Regional Clinics** introduced in North to help U.S. school children
- **2005** **Four millionth recipient**, Hannah, a teenage girl, is helped during a North American Clinic  
**Vision Van helps 6,155 people affected by Hurricane Katrina** in Louisiana and Texas, United States  
**Agordo, Italy Recycling Center** opens

**OneSight Asia Pacific wins the prestigious Australia Business Arts Award** for community services provided through the Croc Festival™ eye care Clinics

- **2006** **Five millionth recipient**, Lavonte, a teenage boy, is helped during a North American Clinic  
**OneSight Asia Pacific holds its inaugural charity golf day**, in New South Wales, Australia
- **2007** **Six millionth recipient**, Victory, helped during an International mission to Thailand  
**Port Washington, NY Recycle Center opens**
- **2008** **OneSight launches the Dr. Stanley Pearle Scholarship Fund** to provide scholarships to student pursuing a degree in Optometry  
**China Regional Eye Care Programs begin** with local Clinic in Tianjin  
**Pederobba, Italy Recycling Center opens**  
**New South Wales, Australia Recycling Center opens**  
**OneSight program is launched at Oakley**; first Oakley employee attends a OneSight Clinic in El Salvador  
**OneSight Asia Pacific conducts first Clinic to Tuvalu**, a small South Pacific island
- **2009** **Seven millionth recipient** Mistie-Lea helped during a Regional Clinic in Sydney, Australia  
**Milan, Italy Recycling Center opens**  
**Columbus, OH Recycling Center opens**  
**EyeBiz, Australia Recycling Center opens**
