

PROGRAM SUMMARY

ABOUT ONESIGHT

OneSightSM, a Luxottica Group Foundation, is a family of charitable programs dedicated to improving vision for those in need worldwide through outreach, research and education. OneSight combines more than 20 years of innovation from three former Luxottica charitable programs – Give the Gift of Sight and the Pearle Vision Foundation in North America and Community I-Care in Australia – into one, new global foundation. Since 1988, these charitable efforts have provided free vision care and eyewear to more than six million people in need around the world and have granted millions towards research and education.

OneSight is a 501 (c)(3) organization, supported by public contributions and Luxottica Group, a world- leader in eyewear manufacturing, designer and distribution.

ANSWERING A NEED

Around the world, approximately 250 million people suffer from poor vision simply because they do not have access to or cannot afford care. Poor vision impedes a child's ability to learn in school and robs an adult of independence, mobility and quality of life. OneSight was founded on the belief that basic vision care is a human right, not a privilege and is committed to providing quality care and eyewear for those in need.

THE DRAMATIC IMPACT

Since the age of six years Angel has been in “special classes” because she did not respond to pictures or letters. After her OneSight doctor's exam, it was revealed that Angel could not see clearly a foot from her nose. As soon as Angel's new glasses were placed on her face, she looked around in amazement and started pointing at things around the room. Just that morning, Angel woke up to her usual world of blur and by that afternoon, her entire world changed – it was the first day of the rest of her life.

An 80-year-old little lady who stood about 4 foot 5 walked through the clinic grasping a bunch of letters. After receiving her reading glasses, at a fairly high prescription, she immediately began to pour through the letters. The translator explained that she had received letters from her family for years that she was unable to read. A simple pair of glasses enables her to catch up on all she has missed with her family and ensures she'll never miss anything again!

ONESIGHT PROGRAMS

○ Global Eye Care

Each year, OneSight volunteers travel to countries around the world to hand-deliver free vision care and eyewear to thousands of adults and children. OneSight works closely with local governments, health care officials and independent doctors of optometry to ensure each Clinic runs smoothly and local recipients receive the best possible care.



To date, Luxottica and other volunteers have run 155 clinics in 31 different developing countries, helping over 3 million people. In 2009, OneSight will conduct 20 Clinics in 14 countries, including first time visits to South Africa and Brazil.

While the majority of eyewear distributed during these Clinics is recycled, new eyewear is manufactured at Luxottica plants across Italy to help fill more complex prescriptions. Recycled eyewear is collected in Luxottica Retail and Independent practitioner's offices around the world. Volunteers then clean and prepare the eyewear for Clinics at one of six Global Eyewear Recycling Centers in Australia, Italy and the United States. Each year, OneSight volunteers recycle more than two million pairs of eyewear for use in Global Clinics.

○ **Regional Eye Care**

OneSight has developed significant program and volunteer support in North America, Australia and China to provide free vision care and eyewear to those in need through organized Regional and Vision Van Clinics. In 2009, OneSight will conduct more than 25 weeks of Clinics across North America and China and in conjunction with Croc Festivals serving Aboriginal communities across Australia.

OneSight also operates three Vision Vans, which travel across North America and Australia bringing clear vision to those in need. Each Van is a mobile optical lab, equipped with everything needed for a complete eye exam and new pair of eyewear. Local doctors and volunteers staff the Vans at each stop.

○ **Community Eye Care**

Local OneSight volunteers help those in need in local communities through Retail/in-store and outreach programs. Throughout the year, OneSight volunteer doctors and employees from participating Luxottica Retail stores, including LensCrafters, Pearle Vision, Sears Optical and Target Optical, provide free eyewear to recipients pre-selected by local charities based on visual and financial need. OneSight volunteers also provide free vision screenings at schools and health fairs, as well as eyewear adjustments and repairs in nursing homes and shelters.

○ **Preventative Eye Care**

The OneSight Research Foundation provides research grants to find better treatments and cures for vision-threatening diseases and disorders. Millions of dollars have been donated towards this research over the past 20 years. OneSight also invests in developing the next generation of optometric professionals through the Dr. Stanley Pearle (founder of Pearle Vision) Scholarship Fund. Begun in 2008, this program provided scholarships to 20, second, third and fourth-year students across North America.
